

COMPONENTS OF NURSING PRACTICE FOR REGISTERED NURSE



A-The responsibilities which any registered nurse can safely accept are determined by the variables in each nursing practice

- The variable are:
- 1- the nurses own qualifications including:
 - * basic educational preparation.
 - * knowledge and skills . •
 - 2- complexity and frequency of nursing care.
 - 3- proximity of clients to personnel .
 - 4- qualifications and number of staff.
 - 5- accessible resources. •
 - 6- established policies ,procedures, practices, channel of communication.

B- Assessment is an ongoing process in this point we need collection and interpretention of data

- Collection of data include:
- * obtaining data from relevant sources regarding the biophysical, psychological, social and cultural factor of the clients
 - * verifying data collected

C-Planning nursing care activities includes identifying the clients needs and selecting or modifying nursing interventions related to the finding of nursing assessment.



- D- Implementation of nursing
- activities is the initiating and
- delivering of nursing care according to an established plan.



E- Evaluation consists of determination the extent to which desired outcomes of nursing care are met and planning for subsequent care

- The components of evaluation include:
 - 1- collecting evaluative data from relevant source.
 - Intervention.
- 2- analyzing the effectiveness of nursing
 - 3- modifying the plan of care



F- Reporting and recording by the registered nurse.



H- Teaching and courseling clients is the responsibility of the registered nurse.
